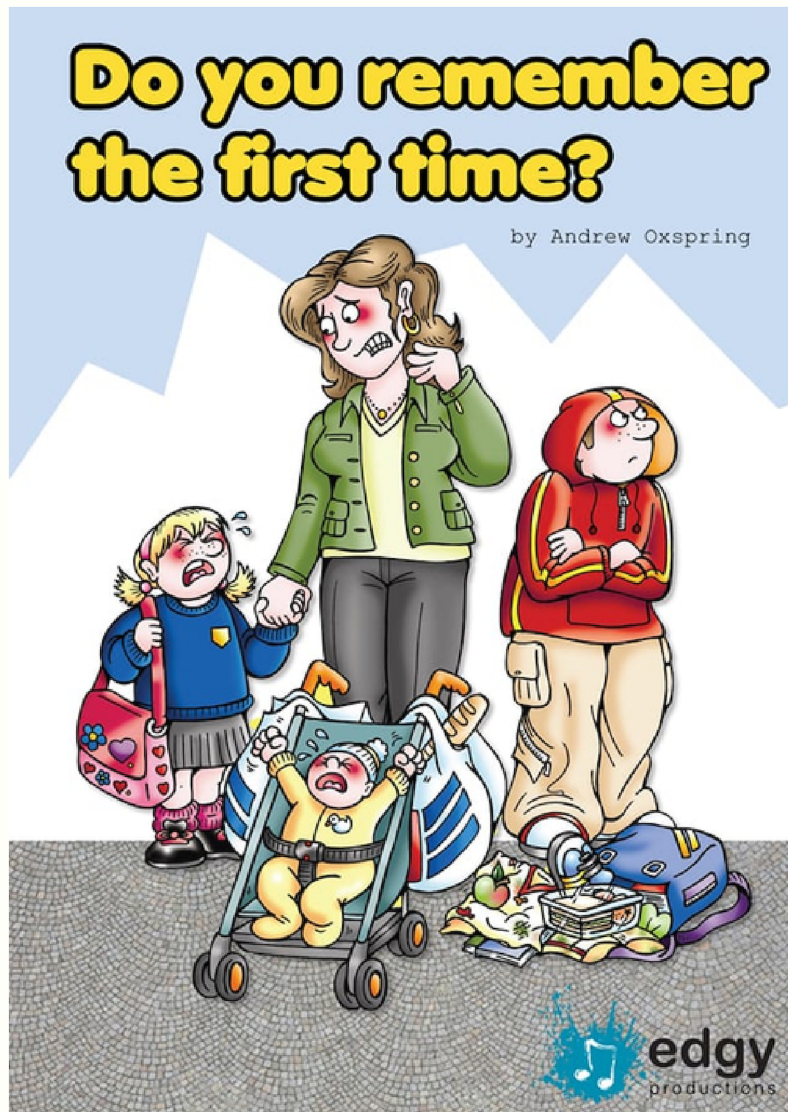
Year 5



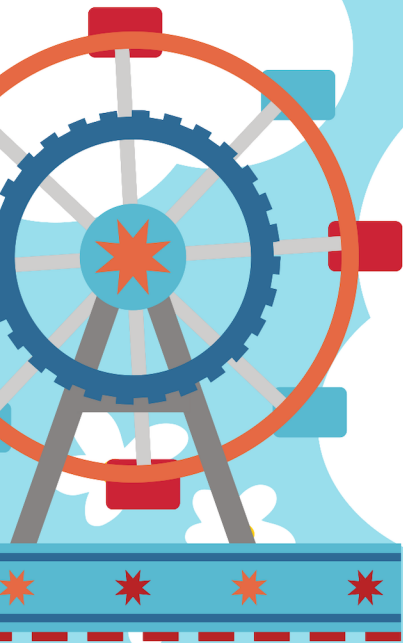
