News of the week:

On **Thursday 2nd April at 1pm**, Mrs Giaccotto will host a half an hour video call with the children in Ebony Class. The call will be free of charge and hosted on Zoom. Parents/Cares will need to download the app **Zoom** to access the call and dial the Meeting ID **968-044-097**. During the video call Mrs Giaccotto will run a Quiz on The Vikings. The quiz will be hosted on **Kahoot**, another app that parents/carers will need to download prior to the call. Mrs Giaccotto will provide more details during the video call.

We ask parents/carers to supervise their children during the entire duration of the call. Should any inappropriate behaviour happen, or inappropriate language be used, Mrs Giaccotto will terminate the call immediately and report the incident(s) to the school.

As part of the call, the children are invited to dress as someone who lived in the time of the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to see each other and consolidate their learning on the topic. We hope to see as many Ebony children as possible.

Learning throughout the week:

Remember to keep active throughout the week. Can you create your own physical activity game to play with a family member? When we are back at school, we will be sharing our ideas and having a go together. Have a go at creating an instructions card for the activity.

Each day - Complete Writing and Maths, read your book at least 20 mins a day and practice times tables.

Read through Shark Fact File see if you can spot any of the writing features: Relative pronouns/clauses, adjectives, subordinate conjunctions/clauses, fronted adverbials. You can make a list of any you might want to use (like when we jot ideas in jotters).2. Plan your non-fiction writing with sub headings like we did in Science when we wrote about the conservation of different animals. Use the Unicorn Report template to plan your subheadings and key vocabulary. Use the Challenge Grid to help you write your sentences. Art	<p>Make a 3D model of a tooth or a whole set of teeth. You can use egg boxes, newspaper to mould shapes of teeth, play dough. Be creative!</p>
French	<p>Page 1 to 4 - practice saying the greetings with your family.</p>
Extended Project	<p>CONTINUE - Vikings and Saxons - Create your own project! Be creative - you could research to design, make and build artefacts/objects/settlements, handwrite or use technology to present information e.g. PowerPoint, Word.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Anglo Saxon and Viking Life - homes, clothes, toys, beliefs, food and drink.
