

## News of the week:

On **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April at 1pm**, Mrs Giaccotto will host a half an hour video call with the children in Ebony Class. The call will be free of charge and hosted on Zoom. Parents/Cares will need to download the app <u>Zoom</u> to access the call and dial the Meeting ID <u>968-044-097</u>. During the video call Mrs Giaccotto will run a Quiz on The Vikings. The quiz will be hosted on <u>Kazhoot</u>, another app that parents/carers will need to download prior to the call. To access the quiz children will need to follow the link <u>https://create.kahoot.it/share/the-vikingsquiz/1ae27090-9bb2-434a-a65b-cbb65195dcfb</u>. Mrs Giaccotto will provide more details during the video call.

We ask parents/carers to supervise their children during the entire duration of the call. Should any inappropriate behaviour happen, or inappropriate language be used, Mrs Giaccotto will terminate the call immediately and report the incident(s) to the school.

As part of the call, the children are invited to dress as someone who lived in the time of the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to see each other and consolidate their learning on the topic. We hope to see as many Ebony children as possible.

### Learning throughout the week:

Remember to keep active throughout the week. Can you create your own physical activity game to play with a family member? When we are back at school, we will be sharing our ideas and having a go together. Have a go at creating an instructions card for the activity. Each day - Complete Writing and Maths, read your book at least 20 mins a day and practice times tables.
