Task A: Using the internet, find out the relevant statistics about Egypt to complete the table.

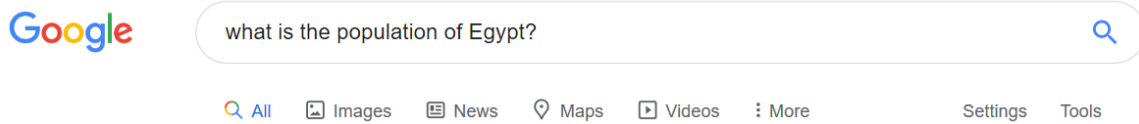


Figure 1 An example of how to search

<u>Density</u> (How much land is used?)		274 people per square kilometre
<u>Temperature</u> (What is the average temperature?)		18 to 25 °C
<u>Gross national income</u> (How much money does the country make each year?)		2.85 trillion dollars
<u>Birth Rate</u> (How many children does each mother have on average?)		1.80 births per woman
